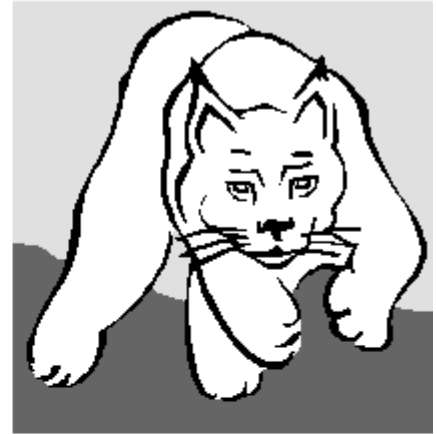


Animals

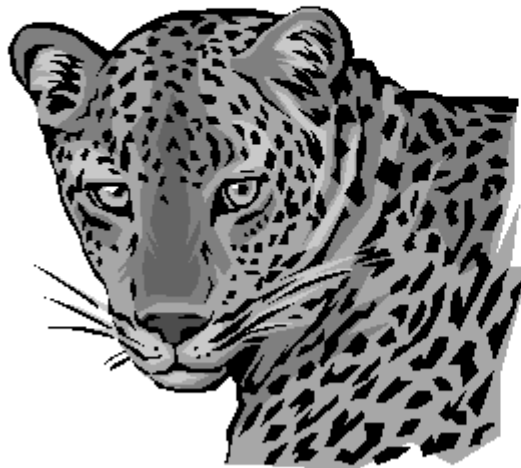
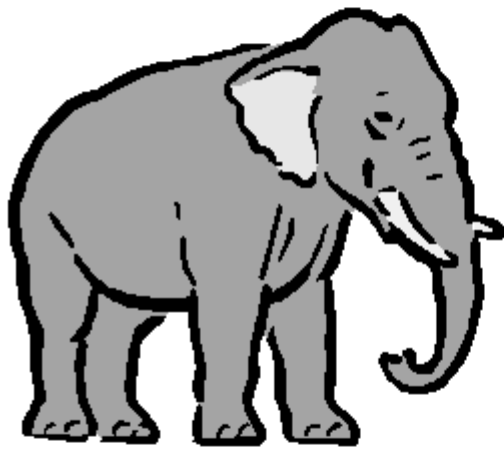

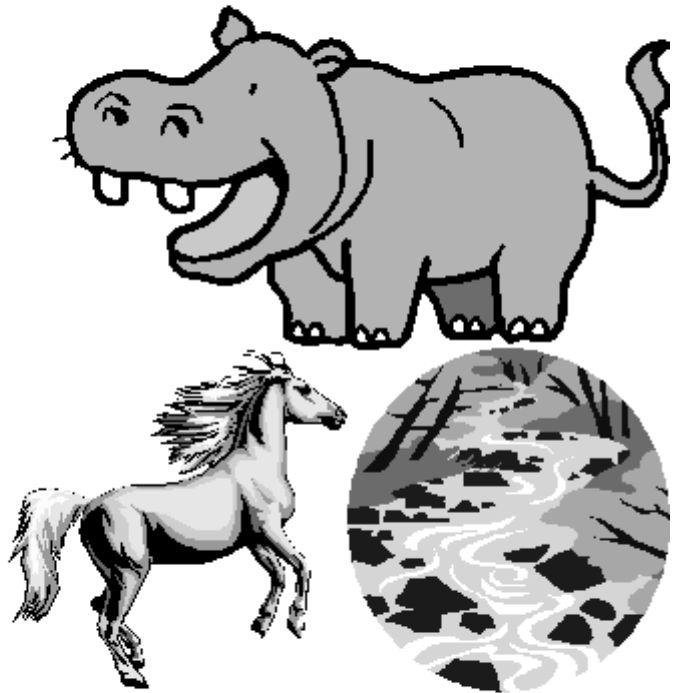
